Heat transfer enhancement of parallel flow and counter flow heat exchanger using the w-cut, triangle, and right angle triangle has been investigated in the present work. Regarding to the experimental results, it can be concluded as follows. Heat exchangers with right angle triangle twisted tape having better heat transfer rate of 217.6kj/kg., heat transfer coefficient rate is 52.29 w/m2k comparing to others inserts. Therefore the amount of heat transfer rate increased is 113.8kj/kg and efficiency increased around 20% comparing to normal twisted tape.


