Annual Report 2022-2023

As the college enters its 14th year, many initiatives, events, and activities have taken place in our institution. Since 2009, we have graduated a total of 2793 students. Both the CSE and ECE departments were accredited by NBA, and our institution is also accreditated NAAC. The fourth largest hydraulic industry in the world, Barani Hydraulics India Private Limited.

The academic year 2022-2023 for second, third, and final years odd semester has been started on August 23, 2022 with the strength of 983 students. The first year classes commenced on November 14, 2022 with the total number of 296 students. Orientation programme was organized by Skills & Brains, coimbatore for first two days. In addition, we begin each day of the class with an orientation on new technical information shared by senior faculty and end with a language quest to help students to enhance their ability to communicate. In April/May 2023, Total number of students appeared in the final semester examination are 140 and 134 students cleared the examination.

The students were provided numerous opportunities to develop their personalities, communication skills, and soft skills, with a focus on holistic student development. In this academic year, infrastructure development and New Lab Establishment are carried out and Sports equipment was purchased.

The library has more than 27838 volumes of books on 7947 titles covering all disciplines of engineering and technology, science & humanities and management studies. The library is open from 8.00.a.m to 7.00.p.m on all weekdays for the student utilization. Our institution is subscribed with Springer and Delnet (Developing Library network for accessing online Journals with all Engineering Disciplines. Students are availed with Wi-Fi facility for their laptops for easy web access.

The entire college campus is facilitated with pure Reverse Osmosis (RO) drinking water with water coolers in every block to cater the need of pure and safe drinking water to all. The installed capacity of RO system is 5000 litres/day in the campus. Solar water heater is installed in hostel, hot water is made available round the clock for wide use of hostel students.

ANNUAL REPORT

Academic Year - 2020-2021

As the college move towards the twelfth year, the year gone by has seen many initiatives, events and activities were undergone in our college. Since 2009 to till date totally 3221 graduated from our institution.

The classes for the second, third and final year students started from 12th August 2020 and for first year students it started from 9th November 2020 through online mode due to covid 19. This year, we followed minimum 9 hours of virtual class for every unit of syllabus completion and a unit wise MCQ test were conducted immediately thereafter in the odd semester. Students took up their odd semester exams during December 2020 in which they had performed excellently and maintained our academic supremacy in Tirupur district by scoring highest pass percentage.

Even semester of this year started on 18th February with minimum 12 hours of virtual class per unit. The students were given ample opportunities to groom themselves towards personality development, communication development, and soft skills focusing on holistic development of students through online mode. Total number of students appeared in the final semester examination are 332 and 328 students cleared the examination.

The Infrastructure development is done where ever necessary and our trustee provide education scholarship for more about 1000 rural and poverty students. College library has a total volume of more than 27282 books in over 8043 titles. Apart from the existing volumes of 69 journals.

Activities in this year focused on all dimensions with the motive of grooming students in overall perspective. To enable this, clubs and cells, all department associations and professional body activities like IEI (Institution of Engineers-India), IETE(Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers), IEEE(Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers) student body and CSI(Computer Society of India) are functioning in our institution.

The Clubs/Associations have organized more than 250 programmes like workshop, seminars, guest lecturers, symposium, alumni interaction, quiz competition from the academic year of 2020 to till date for the benefit of the students. Top officials and technical experts, motivational speakers and experienced faculties from renowned academic

institutions and industrialists have addressed and interacted with our students through these programmes. And we also conducted yoga and social awareness program for the students and faculties through club cells for the benefit of the students to meet the social challenges.

ASSOCIATION EVENT

The various departments association conducts activities of webinars, alumni talks and Virtual Hands on training program in their domains, recent technologies and research oriented topics with the motive of grooming students in overall perspective. Two Faculty Development Programs are conducted by the department of ECE and CSE to provide training in the advanced topic of Internet of Things.

The institution has conducted SZIKRA symposium in 2020 where above 100 students from various institutions has participated actively in the way to bring out their inventions to the society and appreciated by rewards.

VALUE ADDED COURSE

To equip our students on matching the ever-changing needs of industry, additional value added courses like PLC, E- CAD, Digital Image Processing, E-Sim, Internet of Things, CADD, OPTUMG3Field surveying were conducted to our students.

PARTICIPATION

89 Faculty members have participated in various faculty development programs at different institutions, and 22 of our non-teaching staff members have attended administrative training sessions hosted by the institution. Our faculty members received financial assistance for attending conferences, workshops, and other events. This academic year, our faculty members received financial support of Rs. 3,46,150/- for attending the various programs like conferences and workshops. 21 papers have published in reputed international and national journals by our faculty members.

From our institution nearly 243 students have actively attended webinar conducted by various institution in different topics through online platform, 48 also participated in various technical competition as symposium, project expo, conference both in-campus and in other institutions of repute. Totally 148 students visited their core field industries for in-plant training and internship.

ANNUAL REPORT - (2019-2020)

The classes for the second, third and final year students started on 1st June 2019 and for first year students it was started on 5thAugust2019. This year, we followed 14 days contact period for every unit of syllabus coverage and a test immediately thereafter in the odd semester. Students took up their odd semester exams during November/December 2019 in which they had performed well and maintained our academic supremacy in Tirupur district by scoring highest pass percentage.

Even semester of this year started on 16th December 2019 with 14 days contact period per unit. The students were given ample opportunities to groom themselves towards personality development, communication development, and soft skills focusing on holistic development of students. Total number of students appeared in the final semester examination are 296 and 287 students cleared the examination.

Infrastructure development in this academic year is done where ever necessary, thanks to our management for the support rendered. Several laboratories were enhanced in this academic year. All weather road and canal work are completed in our campus.

GOVERNING COUNCIL

We have re-organised our governing council by including experts from reputed educational organizations such as IIT – Madras, Amrita University and industrial experts from Wheels India.

The Governing Council meeting had given several inputs for the working team to implement in view of its development. The college had initiated NBA approval process from this academic year. We had obtained best practices award from ICT Academy for our Self Direct Work Teams (SDWT) initiatives. In the alumni meet conducted in January 2020 more than 100 alumni had participated.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

College library is augmented with about 1500 books this year and at present it has a total volume of more than 27000 books in over 7200 titles. Apart from the existing volumesof 79 journals and 30 magazines, we have about 8TB of NPTEL materials to our library from IIT Madras. JSREC had also become a nodal center for NPTEL courses, students can appear for NPTEL courses through our college. Total investment for library is over Rupees 7.0 Lakhs this year.

CLUBS/ASSOCIATIONS

Activities in this year focused on all dimensions with the motive of grooming students in overall perspective. To enable this, clubs and cells, all department associations and professional body activities like IEI, ACCI, and CSI are functioning in our institution.

The Clubs/Associations have organized more than 50 programmes so far in this academic year for the benefit of the students. Top officials and technical experts, motivational speakers and experienced faculties from renowned academic institutions have addressed and interacted with our students through these programmes. Several cells & clubs organized various activities.

WORKSHOPS, FDP, TRAINING

Teaching staffs of our institution have attended several faculty development programmes both in-campus and in other institutions of repute. 40 Faculty members from various departments has attended a variety of faculty development programs at different colleges for their domain enrichment. In addition with 137 faculty events like conferences, workshops, seminars, industrial training programs have attended by the faculty members in this academic year.

Management provides financial support for faculty members to attend various events like conferences, workshops, and other events. Our faculty member has received financial support of Rs.51350/- for this academic year. Our faculty members has published more than 50 papers in reputed international and national journals this year.

Faculty members are rewarded with cash prizes and appreciations for their research publications and patent publications.

SYMPOSIUM

A National level technical symposium was conducted in our college this year in which more than 100 papers had been received by the various departments. Shri. V.Manokaran Retd. Senior Additional Director, Industrial Safety and Heath, Govt of Tamil Nadu, Chennai was the resource person. The symposium was well organized by the team of our staffs and students. School of management studies had organized an inter collegiate management meet in which more than 100 students participated from 25 other institutions.

STUDENT DETAILS- JOURNALS, INDUSTRAIL TRAINING

The Tamil Nadu pollution board and the department of school education have organized a one day workshop on E- waste management in our campus in which Mr. R Ramesh, Chief Education officer, Tirupur and Smti. Nalini, District Pollution Board officer, Trichy were the chief guests.

Our students of various departments have been visiting many industries related to

their field every semester. In this academic year the students of EEE department visited Mas-Solar Power Station, Coimbatore, the 3rdsem and 5thsem students of ECE department visited Sunshiv Electronics and Sabari Health Care Systems, Coimbatore, for their subject awareness and academic upgradation. The 3rdsem students of Mechnaical department visited Barani Ferrocast for field training.

Alumni **Mr. Manoj** made an interaction with 3rdsem students of Department of CIVIL Engineering about Google Sketch up and 3D Modeling techniques. **Mr.RajeshAdiga**, Operational Manager, ALSTOM, Bangalore made an Online Interaction with 7thsem students of department of Mechanical engineering. A telecast was made by Pudhuyugam TV about the Institute features.

Our students actively involve themselves in proving their abilities outside our institution also, by the way of presenting papers, participating in various competitions etc., in total, in this year alone, 342 papers have published by our students in various platforms like journals and conferences of international importance. Our students attended workshops, seminars, conference and symposiums outside our institution. Through SDWT program 18 first prizes, best papers award, 300 participation certificates were received from various colleges within last one month. Our students had received 18 prizes/Best paper award continuously.

SKILL INDIA

This year our college was given the privilege of organizing District level Skill India Competition. Various competitions like Electric Installation, Brick laying, Water technology, painting and decoration were conducted in the month of January 2020, in which the our college students and the students from various colleges of our district had participated effectively. The winners of various events of the District level Skill India Competition received certificates from the District Collector in the Collectorate, Tirupur.

PLACEMENT

A total of 156 offers had been given to our students in 62 companies so far this year. Our college has organized five mega placement pool drives in which around 300 students from 22 colleges participated.

Our college has also organized Industry 2.O in which the HR's of 8 companies were invited. They had a wonderful interaction with our college students which was very helpful for our students and it turned out to be a huge success.

The department of Training and Placement organized HR Conclave YOU 2.0 in our campus in the month of December 2019 in which Mr. Periasamy Subramanian, Chief Executive Officer, Atal incubation center, Govt. of India, NIFT TEA Apparel and

Knitwear division was the chief guest and Shri T. R Vijaykumar, secretary, Tirupur Exporters Association was the guest of honor. About 7 eminent personalities from HR Domain interacted with the students and this event turned out to be huge success and was very helpful for our students.

To take part in internship activities, our 2nd and 3rd year students have registered themselves in Internshala.

CIVIL DEPARTMENT CONSULTANCY

The department of Civil Engineering has done a consultancy for many industries with the support of Barani Hydraulics India Private Ltd., Coimbatore. More than 100 consultancy and testing services were done by the department of civil engineering in this year worth around 1.2 lakhs.

FUNDING PROPOSAL AICTE

Around 8 online and offline AICTE funding proposals were sent amounting to around 1 crore 80 lakhs.

FUNDING PROPOSAL TNSTC

109 funding proposal were sent to various funding agencies this year by our staff. One proposal is sanctioned for Rs. 40,000 by ICMR to organize a national level seminar. TNSTC had sanctioned Rs. 10,000 as project funding for MBA department, and Rs. 7000 for the Department of Civil Engineering.

In association with Kingmakers IAS academy Chennai we had started Jay Shriram IAS Academy to train our students for competitive exams in which 101 students registered and taking their training.

In view of enhancing green cover over 2000 seed balls were distributed to our students and I am sure that this effort will continue.

ANNUAL REPORT - (2018-2019)

The annual report of the academic year 2018-2019. The classes for the second, third and final year students started this year from 2nd July 2018 and for first year students from September 03, 2018. This year, we followed 14 days contact period for every unit of syllabus coverage and a test immediately thereafter in the odd semester. Students took up their odd semester exams during November/December 2018 in which they had performed excellently and maintained our academic supremacy in Tirupur district by scoring highest pass percentage. Even semester of this year started on 19th December 2018, with 13 day contact period per unit. Total number of students appeared in the final semester examination are 453 and 303 students cleared the examination.

Infrastructure development in this academic year is done wherever necessary. The food court of the college had been enhanced and breakfast and lunch are provided at a subsidized cost to the students, thanks to our management for the support rendered. Several laboratories were enhanced in this academic year to meet out the new regulation requirements. The college buildings are being repainted, sports facilities are enhanced and a new athletic track has been formed.

College library is augmented with about 2600 e-books this year and at present it has a total volume of more than 30000 books in over 8200 titles considering bound volumes and e-books. Apart from the existing volumes of 78 journals and 30 magazines, we have about 8TB of NPTEL materials to our library from IIT Madras. Total investment for library is over Rupees 6.0 lakhs this year. Our college being a nodal center for NPTEL courses, over 100 students and staff had registered and taken various NPTEL courses.

The Governing Council of our institution has been added with experts from reputed industries such as Rane Brake Linings Limited, Barani Hydraulics India Pvt. Ltd. The Governing Council, in its meeting, had given several inputs for the working team to implement in view of the development of our institution. We have initiated activities for accreditation by National Board of Accreditation before the end of this year and ISO certification for quality management system by another three months.





Internal Quality Assurance Cell of our college, in which students and parents are members along with faculty team, contributes for innovations in teaching learning process, thus making it continuously improving.

The students were given ample opportunities to groom themselves towards personality development, communication development, and soft skills focusing on holistic development of students. This year we have started in house training activities for our students in the area of soft skill development, aptitude and communication skill. Skill development training is made as a compulsory activity for every student and included in the time table itself. A special communication trainer has been appointed to improve the communication abilities of our students.

To equip our students on matching the ever-changing needs of industry, additional courses were conducted in our college. Various value adding courses like Pro-E-Creo, ANSYS, ABAQUS, MS PROJECT, VASTHU and ESTIMATION, COMSOL, STADD-PRO, RIVET, CADD, HTML and CSS, PHP and My SQL, Android, IoT, GCC, Advanced PYTHON programming, Embedded C, Arudino programming, Optimization techniques, PCB design, E-Tab, Application of research in social sciences, building drawing, Origin-pro, MATLAB, MINI Tab, XLSTAT, STATA, PLAXIS, OPTUMG3 Field surveying, total station were conducted to our students. More than 850 students attended these courses and got immensely benefitted.

13 of our faculty members and teaching staff members have attended a faculty development programs/administrative training programs at different colleges. Financial support is provided to our faculty members so they can attend conferences, workshops, and other events, our faculty member obtained funding of Rs. 1.04 lakh for the same. Almost all of our staff had attended faculty development programmes outside the college including trainings and internships in industries like Barani Hydraulics, Sharp pumps, super springs, RA fax, Surfine tools, Wheels India, Prime Bio medical systems, Sanjeevi products, Yuken India, Super Auto Forge, Tech 7 Automation, PR Automation, CloudZoo etc. Our staff had published 60 papers in reputed international and national journals this year. Ten faculties are presently pursuing Ph.D., Dr.M.Ramesh HOD-Mechanical and Dr.K.Sampathkumar HOD-EEE had presented a paper and received "Best Academician and Researcher Award" by Innovative Scientific Research Professional, Malaysia.

Activities in this year focused on all dimensions with the motive of grooming students in overall perspective. To enable this, clubs and cells, 7 department associations and

professional body activities like IEI, ACCI, and CSI are functioning effectively. This year we have signed several MoUs with various organisations with the focus of our students' development.

Every club, cell and association had organised several programmes and in total they have organized 103 programmes so far in this academic year for the benefit of the students. Top officials and technical experts, motivational speakers and experienced faculties from renowned academic institutions have addressed and interacted with our students through these programmes.

Six national level technical symposiums were conducted in our college this year. More than 500 papers had been received by the departments and the symposiums were well organized by the team of our students. We are in the process of conducting third international conference at our college on 7th March 2019.

YRC / NSS had organised several programmes and more than 2000 seed balls were distributed to our students for sowing. Several programmes were organised related to environmental protection. Blood Donors Club of our institution in which many students and staff members are members donated more than 100 units of blood so far this year. NSS of our college had organized 2 blood donation camps and one external field programme.

Pongal has been celebrated in our college this year with traditional approach and all the students enjoyed it very much.

As a part of our 10th year celebrations, we organised a grand alumni meet on 26th January 2019. Out of 2900 Alumni who completed their UG or PG programme here, nearly 1000 had attended the meeting and enjoyed the re-union besides affirming their affinity with the institution.

Our students actively involve themselves in proving their abilities outside our institution also, by the way of presenting papers, participating in various competitions etc., in total, in this year, 124 papers have been published by our students in various platforms like journals and conferences of international repute. 1028 of our students attended workshops, seminars, conference and symposiums outside our institution. Our students continue to receive several prizes and best paper awards this year also.

11 of our students attended the youth summit organised by ICT academy of Tamilnadu at Coimbatore. During the winter vacation of this year 354 of our second, third, final year students belonging to all disciplines underwent industrial training in various

industries related to their discipline. Our students got prizes in Road Safety week competition, slogan writing competition, etc. Seven of our student batches have applied for Smart India Hackathon competition and results are awaited.

Our students have performed well in sports also and represented our college in Anna University zonal level sports events such as Kabbadi, Football, Volleyball, Basket ball, Hand ball, Cricket, Kho-Kho and in Athletics. Our students Ms.Mohana Priya of III year ECE and Ms.S.Atchaya of III year Civil bagged prizes in the zonal level Anna University athletic meet. Ms.S.Atchaya had represented Anna University zone 12 in athletics in inter zonal athletic meet.

An Academia Industry Meet had been conducted for our students in which experts from Sanmina, Zeta Global interacted with our students regarding preparation towards career development. In addition, dignitaries from organisations like Pricol, Renualt Nissan, Mindnotix technologies, VI Solutions and Mahindra & Mahindra had visited our campus and interacted with our students. More than 50 industrial guests had shared their experience and expertise to our students throughout the year.

In total 231 offers had been given to our students in reputed companies so far this year. The levels of companies in which our students are placed this year are higher and more students got placed in core companies related to their field.

More than 200 consultancy and testing services were done in this year worth Rs.3 lakhs. 32 funding proposals were sent to various funding agencies this year by our staff. TNSCST had sanctioned a research project to our Management department.
